



Dear Pre K Students and Families,

The staff at PS 119 is so excited that you will be joining our school family in September! Ms. Mann and Mrs. Moran are the PreK teachers and cannot wait to meet you. We ask that you keep some of the following in mind to help prepare your child for school.

- * Do your best to toilet train your child. Toilet training includes hand washing and dressing. While we know that the children are entering at many levels, the more time you put into it now the easier it will be for your child in September. We will naturally assist however necessary but need the foundation in place before we start the year. We realize most children do experience at least one bathroom accident during the course of the year and that is totally understandable. We will need a change of clothes, including socks, packaged and labeled in a large ziploc bag, to be stored in the room.
- * Familiarize your child with their name in print. It will help make them feel comfortable when they enter the classroom and see their name posted in the room.
- * PreK wears a uniform each day. It consists of a green shirt with school logo and khaki pants or skirt. On gym day they must wear sneakers and have the option of a gym uniform as well. Uniforms

can be purchased at Ideal uniform store on Flatbush Avenue.
Sneakers or rubber soled shoes should be worn daily.

- * Please send a healthy snack every day. Healthy snacks include fruit, yogurt or cheese among other things. We do not allow cookies, chips or candy in school.
- * Notify us on day 1 if your child has any allergies.
- * Complete the enclosed information sheet and return on day 1.
- * Have your child wear the enclosed name tag day 1 and each day until we are settled into our routines.
- * Children in PreK have a rest period each day. You may send in a small sheet/blanket or comfort item with your child. However it must come to school inside a sealed large ziploc bag. These bags will be sent home on Fridays for you to clean and send back on Mondays.
- * Read with your child every night.
- * Your child will need a book bag, lunch bag and folder. All items, including their clothing, must be clearly labeled with their first and last name.
- * Please complete the enclosed student information sheet and return on day 1.
